1. Make the Sign of the Cross
2. The Apostles Creed.
3. Our Father.
4. Three Hail Marys.
5. Glory Be to The Father.
6. Announce the First Mystery; then say the Our Father.
7. Ten Hail Marys, while meditating on the Mystery.
8. Glory Be to The Father.
9. Fatima Prayer.
10. Announce the Second Mystery; then say the Our Father and repeat Steps 7, 8 and 9.
11. Continue Third, Fourth and Fifth Mysteries in the same manner.
12. Hail Holy Queen.
13. Let Us Pray Prayer.
14. Make the Sign of the Cross.
